DAY CAMP DEPOSIT AND REGISTRATION POLICY *New*

For the convenience of reserving a spot in a camp, you may make a \$50 deposit per camp. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable to other camps or classes. All deposits are applied to the total session fee. Full fees are due by end of day Thursday, seven business days prior to each session. Balances will automatically be scheduled to be paid by credit/debit card or electronic transfer provided by you at time of registration. If your full payment is not received seven days prior to the start of camp, your spot will no longer be reserved and your deposit is forfeited. Registrations received less than seven business days from the start of camp will be assessed an additional \$25. Registrations for all camps will end at 12:00 p.m. on the Friday (or last business day of the week) prior to the camp. Refunds or credits are not issued for days or partial days missed. Please call the Parks, Arts & Recreation Department at 253-931-3043 for full refund policy.

RESIDENT DISCOUNT FEE

The City of Auburn recognizes people living within Auburn's city limits support, through their city taxes, the City's Parks, Arts & Recreation services. Because of this, the City offers its residents a discount on selected recreational programs.
