CHECKLISTS

The following checklists are provided to help provide eligibility and ensure a complete application. Failure to provide the following information may cause a proposal to be denied:

Eligibility Checklist

- Are you a part of a group of at least 3 or more people who are representing a targeted area in the City limits of Auburn (HOA, non-profit, place of worship, etc.)?
 - i. If you are not a part of an incorporated entity, the City can work with you to try to find a partner organization, but there are no guarantees that one will be available.
- Is your community group inclusive of all those who would be affected by the proposed project?
- Does your project provide one of the below services to your community group?
 - Opportunity to connect residents with one another
 - Creates an attachment between residents and their community
 - Helps children excel and stay in school
 - Maintains safe and beautiful communities in Auburn
- Do you have the support of the majority of the affected group?
 - i. If not, try to get the support or re-apply next year with community support.
- Can you match the amount you are requesting from the City? Ways to match include:
 - i. Volunteer hours
 - ii. In-kind donations
 - iii. Donated services
 - iv. Cash
 - v. Supplies donated
- Can you afford to fund the project in its entirety upfront while waiting for reimbursement from the Matching Grant?
